-largest navy (assembled in NY)

-19,000 untrained army

Trenton – 1<sup>st</sup> turning point o December 23, Washington read Thomas Paine (quote) -["These are the times that try men's souls..."] -renewed spirit



-Crossed Delaware on Dec 25th

- -took drunk Germans and British at Trenton (James Monroe wounded)
- o Cornwalis ordered to punish Washington [for fighting in winter ;)]
- o Saw the campfires, but found only ashes
- o Washington had gone around and captured Princeton!

3. WHAT BRITISH ATROCITIES IN NEW JERSEY HELPED AROUSE AMERICAN WRATH? (81) British Strategy

o Terrorize American families [attacked families in their homes!]

o Germans said it made up for low pay

o Isolate New England (map) [typical war strategy]

o British General Gentleman Johnny Burgoyne out of Canada

o Beat American General Gates at Ticonderoga [refused to place a cannon on a hill to defend]

o Gates was secretly trying to get Congress to appoint him in Washington's place.


o Gates took credit and wrote Congress of his
