Provision 62 – Pay set by Congress and paid by Congress.
o Parliament = no salary until 1893

o Articles of Confed had Each state pay delegates. WHO OBJECTED TO CONGRESS BEING ABLE TO SET ITS OWN SALARY? (341-45) o Madison said "indecent" to fix own salary. $0.1789 = \frac{6}{day}$. o See chart p. 341 [raised to \$1500 annual, 1813] o 1815 many were defeated for voting themselves a salary. (346-47) 5. **Provision 63** Congressmen immune from arrest to and from sessions o except for treason, felony, or breach of peace o historically arrested for alleged debt o prevent voting on a critical issue o obsolete now Provision 64 - Immune from libel or slander while speaking on floor o Libel = false written statement o Slander = false verbal statement o Ensures freedom of speech to investigate charges or rumors
