A Free, Civilized Society

- becomes prosperous
- US has become super-prosperous
- prosperity attracts predators

- How much defense?
 - enough to discourage attack

Franklin on Defense

- Do all in our Power
- Ask for assistance from God (quote)
- Secure peace by preparing for war (quote)
- Our leaders owe us protection

5. FRANKLIN WARNED: "MAKE YOURSELVES **_SHEEP_** AND THE **_WOLVES_** WILL EAT YOU."

- o Strength makes friends of enemies (quote)

Washington on Defense

- o Knew the necessity of strong defense
 - no navy
 - no trained army
 - no support
 - could have been bitter
- o Don't wait till attacked to build military
- o Must have complete defense

6. FROM 1945 TO 1980, THE U. S. HAD FOLLOWED THE PHILOSOPHY OF MUTUALLY ASSURED **DESTRUCTION** .

- o Today = Mutually Assured Destruction
 - MAD = destroy people

7. PRESIDENT REAGAN ATTEMPTED TO IMPLEMENT A DEFENSE PROGRAM OF MUTUALLY ASSURED **SURVIVAL** .

- o Mutually Assured Survival (Strategic Defense Initiative)
 - destroy things not people

Duty to God to Preserve Freedom

- o Sam Adams
 - God gave us freedom
 - No man can rightly give it up
- o Founders were peace-loving not pacifists.
- o Be so strong, it is too risky to attack.
