We are all being forced to deal with what is called a potential "Pandemic" with this Coronavirus-19. Corona viruses are flu-like viruses that have appeared in various places of the world with varying potentials to spread because of their contagious nature. This one is less of a danger in it's power, but because of it's contagious quality, synthetic and mutating tendency, it is especially threatening.

There have been other times when such diseases have done the same. Always panic seems to make them worse than reality and it can be the same with this one. Jesus dealt with illnesses in His day too.

Over 150 times in the English NKJV "fear not" appears and 25 of those in the NT; Matthew (3); Luke (7); John (1); Romans (2); 2 Corinthians (1); Galatians (1); Philippians (1); Colossians (1); 2 Timothy (1); Hebrews (3); 1 Peter (1); 1 John (1); Revelation (2) He always claimed or it was implied He had a supernatural power over the source of those fears though He did not always remove the threat of them. He proclaimed, however, "Trust God" instead! This means that the

Believer is literally indestructible while doing the Will of God.
Note what the *physician Luke* presented in his Gospel:

Luk 5:12 And it happened when He was in a certain city, that behold, a man who was full of leprosy saw Jesus; and he fell on *his* face and implored Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean."

Luk 5:13 Then He put out *His* hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately the leprosy left him.

"Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

2 Timothy 1:7 For **God hath not given us the spirit of fear**; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Hebrews 11:27 By faith he forsook Egypt, **not fearing** the wrath of **the king**: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.

Deuteronomy 31:8 And the Lord, he it is that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: **fear not**, neither be dismayed.

Psalms 56:4 In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; **I will not fear what flesh can do unto me**.

Zechariah 8:13 And it shall come to pass, that as ye were a curse among the heathen, O house of Judah, and house of Israel; so will I save you, and ye shall be a blessing: **fear not**, but let your hands be strong.

Isaiah 44:8 **Fear ye not**, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? yea, there is no God; I know not any.

Psalms 46:1-3 God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah.

Isaiah 54:14 In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; for **thou shalt not fear**: and from **terror**; for it **shall not come near thee**.

Isaiah 35:4 Say to them that are of a fearful heart, **Be strong, fear not**: behold, your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompence; he will come and save you.
